Parking Information for Juniors and Seniors

Student Parking Contracts can be printed from the Boone website under Students, then Student Parking or picked up in the front office. Please make sure that you have the parking contract for the current school year, 2021-2022. The link to the Google Form will be there as well.

In addition to completing the Student Parking Contract, you must also complete the parking decal application online via <https://tinyurl.com/21-22ParkingBHS>. The form will open on July 12th at 12pm. Parking spaces are assigned on a first come, first serve basis through the online application. Required information for the application will include:

1. Student Information (name, student and driver's license number and contact information)
2. Vehicle Information (up-to-date vehicle plate number, year, make, model, year, and color)
3. Required documents to be uploaded (current driver's license, Boone Student ID, SchoolPay receipt, completed and signed parking contract)

The only form of payment that will be accepted will be SchoolPay, the online payment service at <https://www.schoolpay.com>

- If you are a Senior and would like to paint your parking space, you will have two transactions: \$75 for the space and \$15 for personalization.
- All regular parking spaces (Senior non-personalized and Junior lot) cost \$75.
- Use of SchoolPay does not guarantee a parking spot.

If you will be driving multiple vehicles, you must complete the application and parking contract for each vehicle.

If you are a Senior and you would like to personalize your space, you will need to complete an additional Google Form and upload your design for approval. The contract form can be found at <https://tinyurl.com/21-22SeniorPaintingBHS>.

Your decal may be available for pick up during Braves are Back on Monday, August 9th from 2:30-4:00 pm if your application is completed by Wednesday, August 4th.

The student, or a family member over the age of 21, may pick up the decal. They must bring a valid ID and the completed and signed parking contract with obligations cleared by the media center to pick up the parking decal.


