Testing season has begun! Parents, we need your assistance in helping our students approach the exams in a positive manner. The key to success is preparation and you can help your child do just that in several ways. Since the assessments measure what your child is studying in class, talk

to your child each day about what he or she is learning. If your child is nervous about the exams or if his or her grades indicate that they need additional practice, then encourage your child to prepare at home with programs such as iReady and Khan Academy. We also offer after school tutoring every Tuesday and Thursday until the end of April. Additionally, since many of these tests are computer-based, have your child practice using a computer testing format such as those found on fsassessments.org prior to the exam so that students are comfortable. On testing days, please make certain that your child arrives at school on time having had a good night's sleep and a nutritious breakfast. Most importantly, tell your student to relax and do their best. Remember that you are the best cheerleader that your child can have! While testing is a significant event during the last weeks of school, please don't forget to participate in other key activities including our Spring Fling on April 3rd, track meets and our spring musical concerts. 

Dear Parent/Guardian of an ELL Student

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that your student will be taking the ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Assessment between January and March. ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 measures your student's progress in listening, speaking, reading, and writing English language skills. Later this spring, your student will receive an Individual Student Report that provides information about how well he or she is progressing in the English language.

Please review the following policies with your child before testing:

- **Electronic Devices** - If your student is found with ANY electronic devices, including, but not limited to, cell phones and smart phones, at any time during testing OR during breaks, his or her test section will be invalidated, which means it will not be scored. The best practice is for students to leave electronic devices at home or in their backpacks on the day of testing.
- **Leaving Campus** - If your student leaves campus before completing a test they have started (for an appointment, illness, etc.), he or she WILL NOT be allowed to complete that test section. If your student does not feel well on the day of testing, it may be best for him or her to wait and be tested on the make-up day.


