



This information was updated by our district on 10/1/24. There is now an initial cost of \$35 for having your fingerprints done in order to become a BPS Registered Volunteer and an annual \$8 fee for renewal.

### What is a Registered Volunteer able to do?

Registered Volunteers are able to work in the classroom, work one on one with students, assist with athletic coaching, help office staff with filing and copying, work in the Library/Media Center, work concession stands for athletic events, and attend in-county and out-of-county field trips as chaperones.

If you're currently a Registered Volunteer, keep in mind you must renew your status before it expires at a cost of just \$8.00 annually. This can be taken care of at District and School Security or on the BPS website.
