Beginning Band News

Beginners met on September 3rd after school for "Basic Training" to receive their instruments and go over fundamentals with professionals. During the first school quarter, students fined tuned their skills and learned to assemble, hold, produce a tone, play five notes, articulate, and connect notes so they can perform melodies like the *infamous* "Hot Cross Buns!" For the second quarter, beginners are currently honing their skills and learning to read music in preparation for their first performance at the Winter Concert in December!

This year, our beginning band has 9 flutes, 23 clarinets, 16 trumpets, 11 trombones, 9 euphoniums and 12 percussionists. Some of these students will be transferring to similar "pathway instruments" like rench horn and tuba in January. Others will become doubler's on saxophone, oboe, or bassoon in 7th grade.
