Did you know you are able to check your student record for all current school materials that you have checked out along with any outstanding fees and fines?


- 1. On your Launchpad click on "INSTRUCTIONAL APP"
- 2. Click on "FOLLETT DESTINY"
- 3. You should be logged in already. If not, you log in with the same info you log into your Chromebook.
- 4. Click on the top tab "MY INFO"
- 5. This will show your current checkouts and fees/fines. A list of your current checkouts will appear first. Scroll down to see Fees and Fines.

<u>Note</u>: It will not show your Chromebook because that is checked out in a different system other than Destiny.
