 - o The Boys' team placed **3rd at Regionals** and **15th at States**.
- Our Swim and Dive Teams continued their dominance:

- Our Varsity Football Team ended the season with a record of 5 wins and 5 losses. Congratulations to Dylan

Xayasongkham, Walter Wolfe, Nico D'Angio, Matt Redman, and Mikey Shoro, who were selected to play in the Pinellas North/South Senior All-Star Football Game.

- Miley Hildebrand and Cassidy McCraney were selected to the Pinellas North/South All-Star Cheerleading Team.
- Our **Boys' and Girls' Bowling Teams** had remarkable seasons:
 - The Boys' Varsity team finished Runner-Up at PCACs and placed 3rd at the State District Tournament.

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CONGRATULATIONS



CALENDAR UPDATES

The School Board approved updates to the instructional calendar at a special meeting on October 29th, 2024.

The changes ensure that students meet state requirements for instructional time. The new schedule addresses time lost due to Hurricanes Helene and Milton.

Students will attend school on Jan. 6, 2025, which was a designated make-up day, and Feb. 17, 2025, which will be a

In addition, the last day of school for students, May 29, 2025, will change from an early-release day to a full day of instruction.

The School Board also agreed to waive first semester exams to add four days of instruction back to the calendar.

The amended Instructional Calendar was recommended based on input from multiple stakeholder groups.
