#### **FY23-24 Student Parking Decal**

<u>Decal cost is \$75.00 paid only on Schoolcash Online. Parking Decals are only issued to students that have a valid driver's license and meet the following requirements:</u>

- 1. Mandatory volunteer hour requirement (12th grader needs 20 hours, 11th grader needs 15 hours, 10th grader needs 5 hours). The volunteer hours must be recorded in SIS prior to receiving a decal.
- 2. Student must have a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- 3. Student must be free of financial obligations.

The application is a Google form that must be completed with all attachments uploaded. The link to this form is found on the Spanish River website under the Student & Parents tab You will need to upload 4 items to the form - the current vehicle registration, a current insurance card, your Florida driver's license and the parking decal receipt from schoolcashonline. Failure to provide the required documentation will delay your application. You will receive an email to your school email once the decal is ready to be picked up in Suite Silver.

#### **Senior Graduation Visits**

School counselors visited all 12th grade students during English classes at the beginning of September to check graduation tracks. We also had a presentation in the theater during an open house for parents of these seniors. #### **Tutoring**

National Honor Society tutoring will be starting up again soon. This is FREE to all students and available during both lunches. It will

be located in the 3000 building in Mrs. Stravro's room #3103. Stay tuned to the morning announcements for the dates.

#### Attendance

Attendance is critical to learning for all students. Statistics show that those who attend all their classes on a regular basis have a higher academic success rate. Please ensure your child attends school on time!

#### **Understanding Semester Grades, Credits, & GPA**

The school year is divided into 2 semesters:

- 1st semester is from August-December and is made up of the grades from 1st quarter (40%), 2nd quarter (40%), and semester exams (20%). Students will receive .50 credit for each first semester class they pass.
- 2nd semester is from January-May and is made up of the grades from 3rd quarter (40%), 4th quarter (40%), and semester exams (20%). Students will receive .50 credit for each second semester class they pass.
- EOC subject-area classes are year-long courses with 1.0 credit awarded for successful completion of the course. These classes include Algebra 1, Geometry, Biology, and U.S. History. The final course grade will consist of 70% in the coursework (grades from 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th quarter and the midterm exam) and 30% in the EOC exam grade.

The semester and final grades received in each class impact the cumulative GPA, and are based on a 4.0 scale: A = 4.0 B = 3.0 C = 2.0 D = 1.0 F = 0.

\* Honors courses are weighted at 1.125 times the standard scale. - AP, IB, AICE, and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted at 1.50 times the standard scale.
