Guidance – Scheduling

We are working on schedules for the 2022-2023 school year and would like to let you know about some exciting opportunities you may qualify for.

- 1. Senior Privilege: If you are an on track with your courses and have a GPA over a 2.5, you are eligible for a period off.
- 2. Credit for Work: If you have a job and maintain your employment throughout the school year, you are eligible for 1 period off for every 5 hours you work. Maximum 2 periods off.
- 3. Dual Enrollment courses through IRSC: You must have a 3.0 GPA and the correct test scores to qualify. You may take your courses at the college and decrease the number of courses you need to take at VBHS. Four college courses equals a full course load. If you are interested in any of these options, please reach out to your counselor. Your parent will need to complete the VBHS Nontraditional Contract on FOCUS,

we can assist you and complete the form over the phone as well.

Path Advisor Program- "Preparing and Advising to Higher Education"

Jessica Wood will the PATH advisor for the 2023 school year. She has been a counselor at Vero Beach High School since 2005 and has extensive experience with the college application and financial aid process both as a counselor and a parent. As PATH advisor, she will be hosting student and parent information sessions and webinars. Students in all grade levels will receive important information regarding high school and their post secondary path through presentations in their classes. The PATH program will also be providing college essay writing, financial aid, and scholarship application workshops. Students and their parents will be encouraged to use their SCOIR accounts this year to research, prepare for and begin the application process. All parents are encouraged to verify that they have an email address in FOCUS as emails will periodically be sent home with important information and dates. We are very excited for the upcoming program this year.





You are about to enter your final year of high school and should be preparing to start the college application process. Most college applications are due no later than November 15. In the fall, you will be meeting with your counselor and the PATH advisor to assist you throughout the process. There will be a schedule of application and essay workshops sent out the first week of school as well.

Many applications will require a counselor email so that your transcripts and recommendations can be uploaded. We are requesting that all students use the following email address for their college applications this year instead of their individual counselor emails: dist.vbhs.collegeapp@sdirc. onmicrosoft.com

This common email address will provide a streamline approach to monitoring student applications and deadlines. If you have any questions, you may reach out to your student's counselor when they return on July 20 or to Mrs. Wood, PATH Advisor/Guidance Director.

Parking Sticker Sales For 2022-2023 School Year



Parking permit applications must be filled out and signed <u>by both student and a parent/guardian</u>. In addition to the two forms, the following must be brought in at the time the application is submitted: \$40.00 (cash or check made payable to VBHS), valid driver's license (not a learner's permit), current insurance card, and current vehicle registration. If all paperwork is not <u>current</u>, you will **NOT** be issued a permit. If you do not have a license yet, but will have a license on or before **October 14, 2022**, you may reserve a parking spot

by submitting all other paperwork and making payment. Reserved spots will be held <u>only until October 28, 2021</u>. At that time, the spot may be sold to another student and there will be NO refund of the parking fee.

PARKING IS A PRIVILEGE - No refunds will be given if parking privileges are revoked.

In addition to the specific parking lot rules contained on the signed Parking Permit Rules authorization form, the following apply to <u>acquire</u> and <u>retain</u> your parking privilege:

- You must maintain a 2.0 or above GPA.
- You must meet and maintain the 90% attendance requirement.
- You must not be on the school's Obligations List.
- A school suspension, 9 or more unexcused absences, or excessive tardies may result in the loss of your parking privilege.
- Leaving campus during the school day without authorization WILL result in the loss of your parking privilege.

You must come on the date/time specified based upon your end of year <u>unweighted</u> GPA for advance parking selection. If you are unavailable on the assigned date, you may send all documents with a third party. Keep in mind that the person who represents you will be choosing your parking spot. After the date assigned, students can get a parking spot from 7:30am to 2pm beginning on August 8th. Once school starts, you can get a parking spot before school, after school, or during lunch only.
